Chrism Mass at the Cathedral - Wednesday 28th March 2018

A coach will depart as follows: Arbroath St. Thomas': 5.30pm; Carnoustie Maule St: 5.45pm; Carnoustie St. Anne's: 5.50pm; Monifieth High St at Reform St: 5.55pm; Broughty Ferry at PO Bar: 6.05pm

The coach will return from outside the Cathedral after Mass at approximately 8.30pm.

Mass of The Lord's Supper – Thursday 29th March 2018

A coach will leave St. Thomas' at 6.15pm, to St. Anne's, returning at approximately 8.30pm - 8.45pm.

The coach will take passengers to Cliffburn and Auchmithie on return journey if required.

A coach will also leave from Broughty Ferry Library at 6.20pm and Monifieth High Street opposite Reform Street at 6.30pm to St Anne's, returning at approximately 8.30pm-8.45pm.

The Great Easter Vigil - Saturday 31st March 2018

A coach will leave St Thomas' at 7.15pm, to St Anne's returning at approximately 10.15–10.30pm immediately after Mass. The coach will take passengers to Cliffburn and Auchmithie if required.

A second coach from St Anne's to Arbroath will depart at 11.45pm. Coach will also take passengers to Cliffburn and Auchmithie on second return journey if required.

A coach will also leave from Broughty Ferry library at 7.20pm, and Monifieth High Street opposite Reform Street at 7.30pm to St Anne's, returning at approximately 10.15 – 10.30pm immediately after Mass.

A second coach from St Anne's to Monifieth and Broughty Ferry will depart at 11.45pm.
